- Over the past three years Exmouth residents have given the community-led steering group for the Exmouth Neighbourhood Plan clear and constructive views on how they want the town to develop.

- Your Chance to say "Yes" or "No". The referendum will be on **Thursday 21st March**. The question asked in the referendum will be: **'Do you want East Devon District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Exmouth to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?'**

REFERENDUM RESULT

- If there is majority support at the referendum, the Plan will have a real influence whenever relevant developments are proposed.
- There will also be extra money available to spend in Exmouth on projects identified in the Plan. These include five proposed infrastructure projects:
 - extension and enhancement of Valley Parks
 - improvement of cycle and footway networks
 - new library and museum complex
 - improved sports and leisure facilities to increase health and well-being
 - arts and craft facilities, interpretation centre and community hall.
- The Plan is an evolving document subject to review. That means any resident will be able to put forward ideas on what should be in the next version. The community will continue to be engaged and the process will be transparent.
